<b>verb</b>	expresses an action or a state/condition	Statement: Subject + <u>verb</u> Question: <u>Verb</u> + subject (+ <u>verb</u> ) Command/Imperative: <u>Verb</u>	walk be become
<b>adjective</b>	modifies/describes nouns  <i>Answers Which (one)? What kind? How many?...</i>	<u>adjective</u> + noun Subject + linking verb + <u>adjective</u>	red young my, your, his,... whose, what,... this, that, these,...
<b>adverb</b>	modifies/describes verbs, adjectives, adverbs, sentences, and sometimes nouns  <i>Answers How? When? Where? How often? How much?</i>	<u>adverb</u> + verb (+ <u>adverb</u> ) <u>adverb</u> + adjective <u>adverb</u> + adverb <u>adverb</u> + sentence (+ <u>adverb</u> ) <u>adverb</u> + noun	fast very suddenly sometimes only
<b>preposition</b>	shows the relationship of a noun or pronoun to some other word or group of words  <i>Answers How? When? Where? How often? How much?</i>	<u>preposition</u> + noun/noun phrase/pronoun	in around during beyond according to because of
